Cool Mille CRAFT SUN CATCHERS

Learning Objectives

How things look different when the sun shines on or through them.

Resources

- Tissue paper (different colours)
- · PVA glue
- Paintbrush
- · Cling film
- Plate
- Card shapes with cut out centres, e.g. hearts, diamonds, squares or any shape you like.

Instructions

- 1. Cut up the tissue paper into small pieces.
- 2. Put the cling film over the plate.
- 3. Mix the PVA glue with water. Then get the children to stick the tissue paper over the cling film.
- 4. Then using a paintbrush, paint the PVA glue and water mixture over the top of the tissue paper.
- 5. Lay the shape you use on top of the glued tissue paper, draw around the outside of the shape and glue this to the back of the shape.
- 6. Once dry, hang or put up on the window and watch what happens when the sun shines.
